1. Turning on !



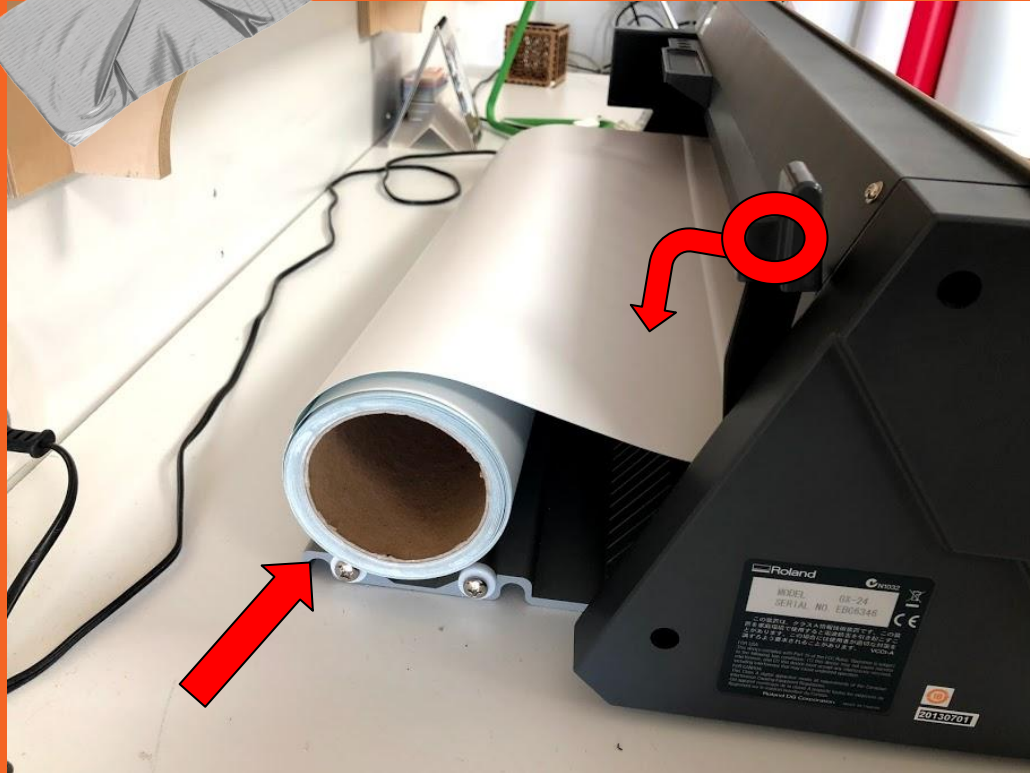
Turn on with the blue button

2. Setting the vinyl roll

→ Roll placed in cradle

As on picture

→ Push the lever down

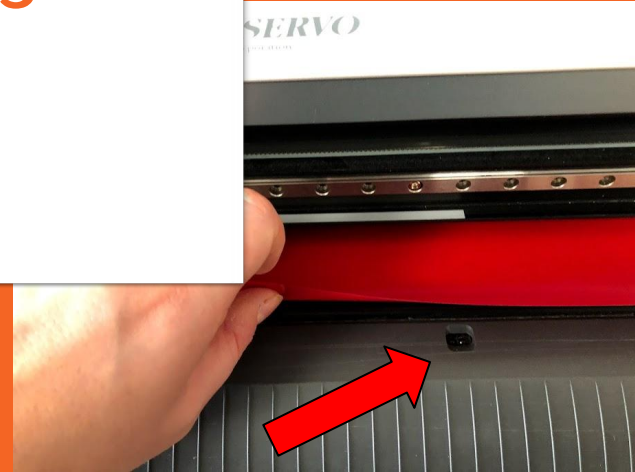




3. Roll threaded

Material threaded through

- Under wheels
- Over lense



5. Setting the wheels

→ Positioning the wheels

The wheels are supposed to be on both ends of the material

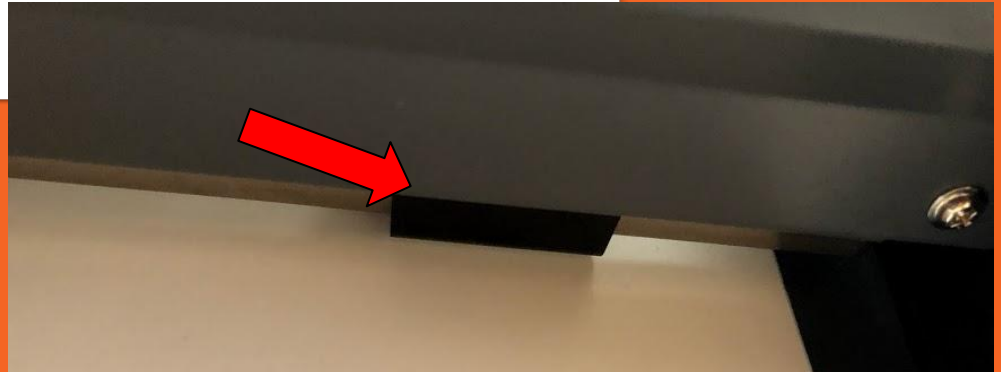
→ Under the white markings



6. Setting the wheels

→ **Wheels are moved on the back of the vinyl cutter**

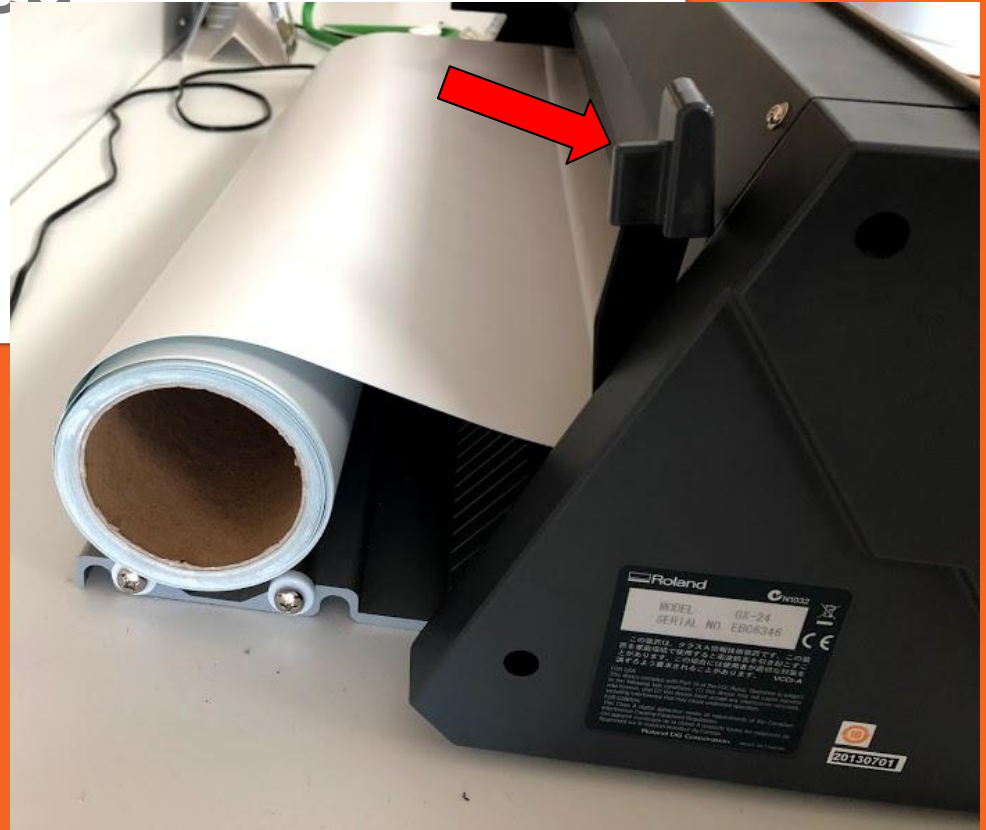
Black plastic pieces that you can move back and forth



7. Material locked

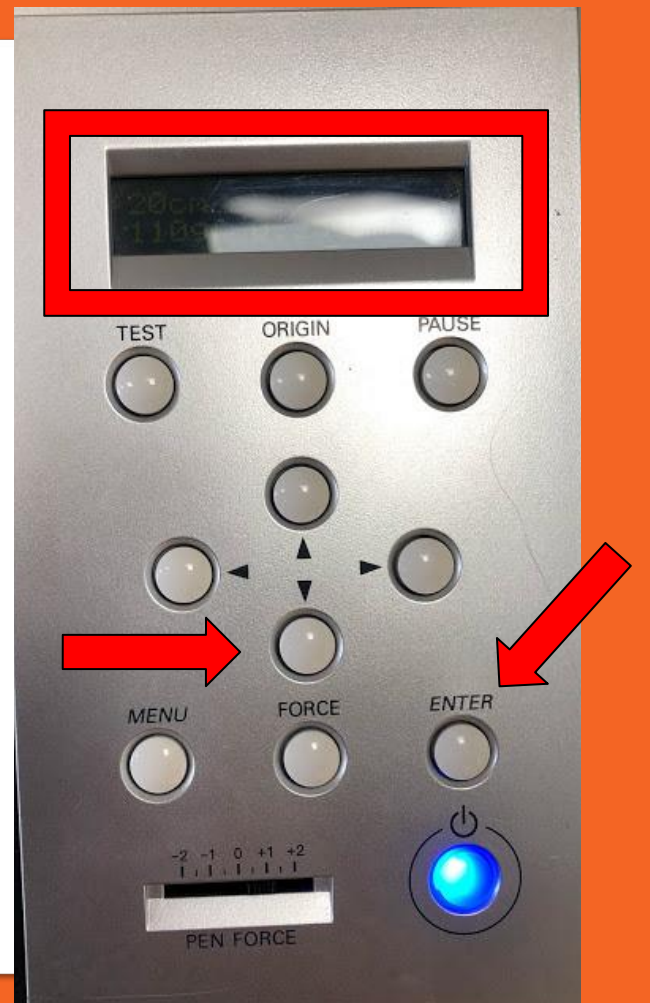
→ **Pull the lever up**

Then the material is locked

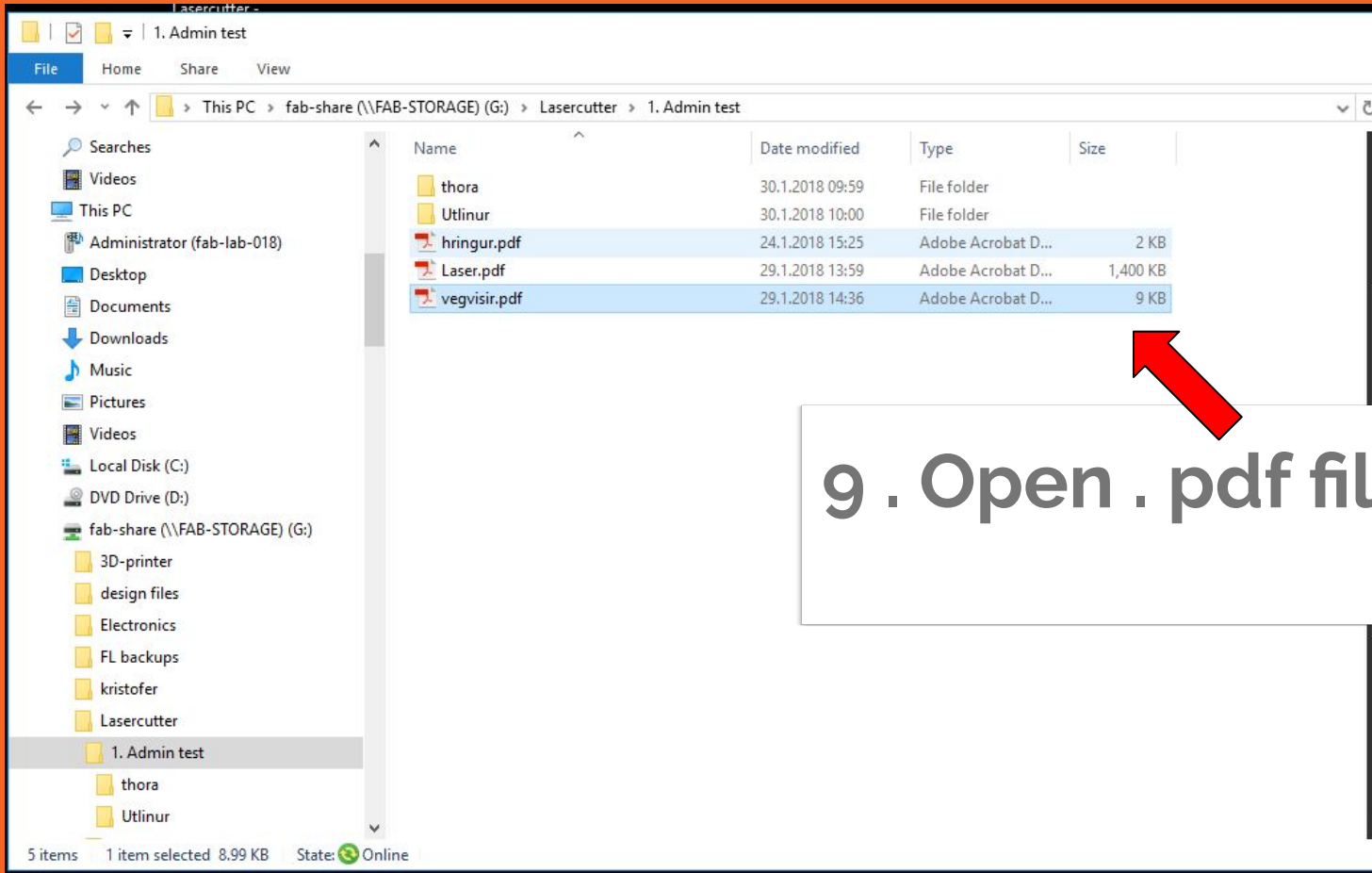


8. Settings for the vinyl cutter

- **Arrow Button**
- **Check screen**
- choose "Edge" for roll
- choose "Piece" for a Piece
- **Press enter**

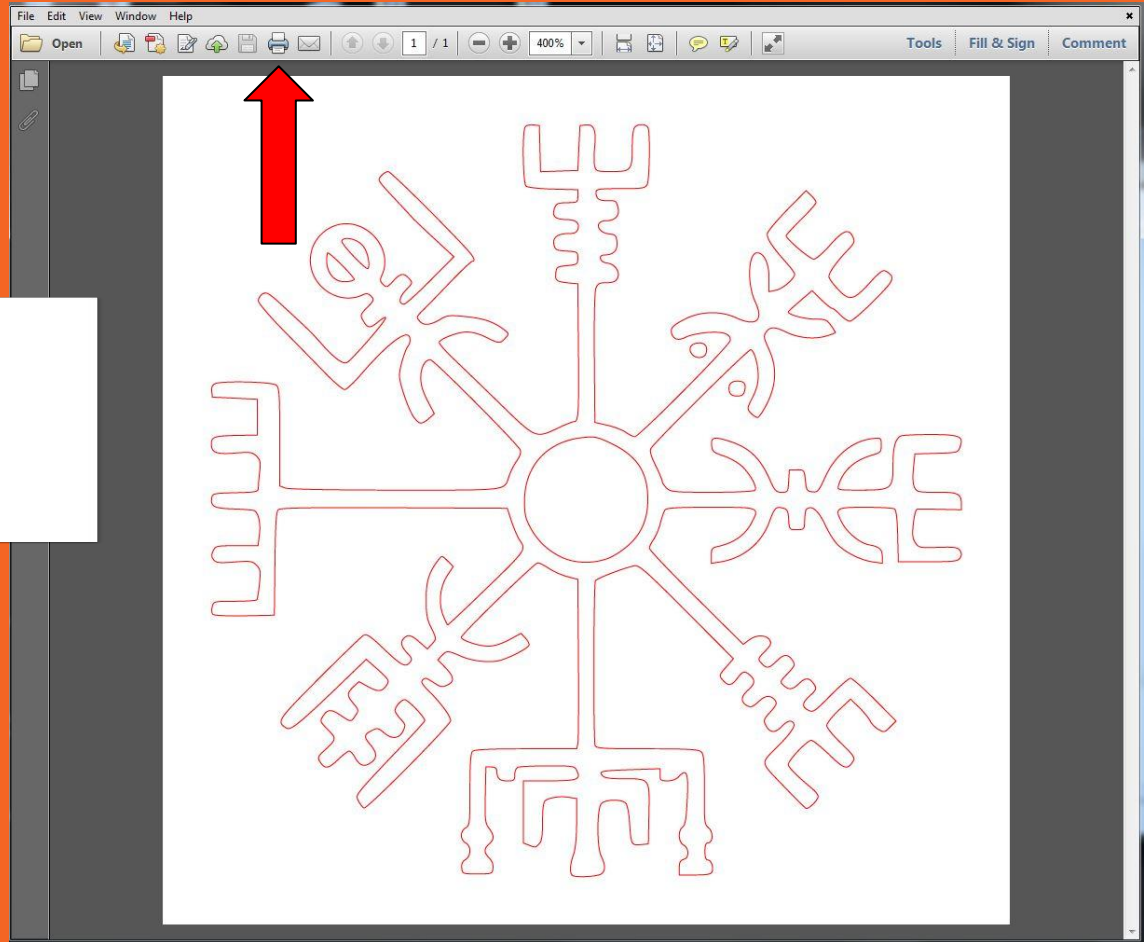


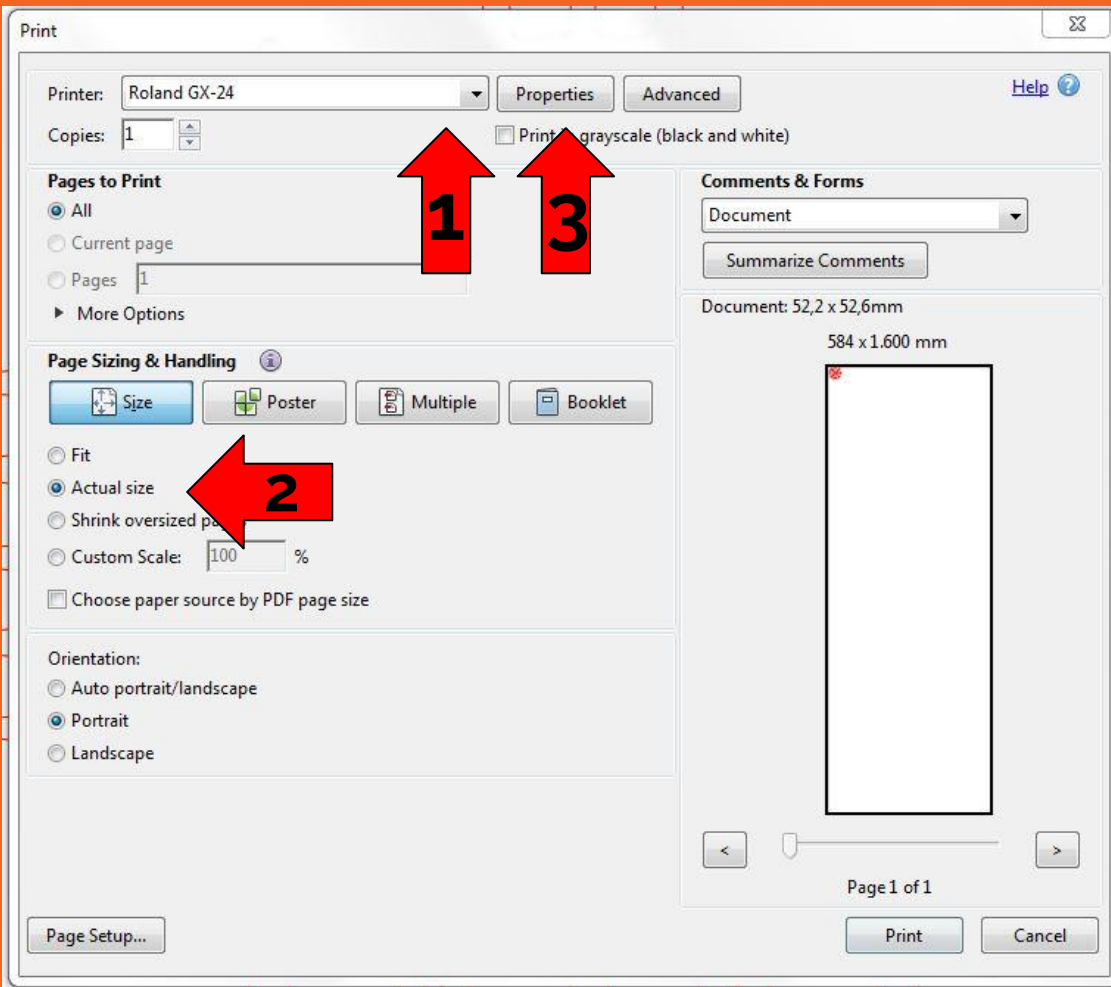
**Now you can move

10. Press print

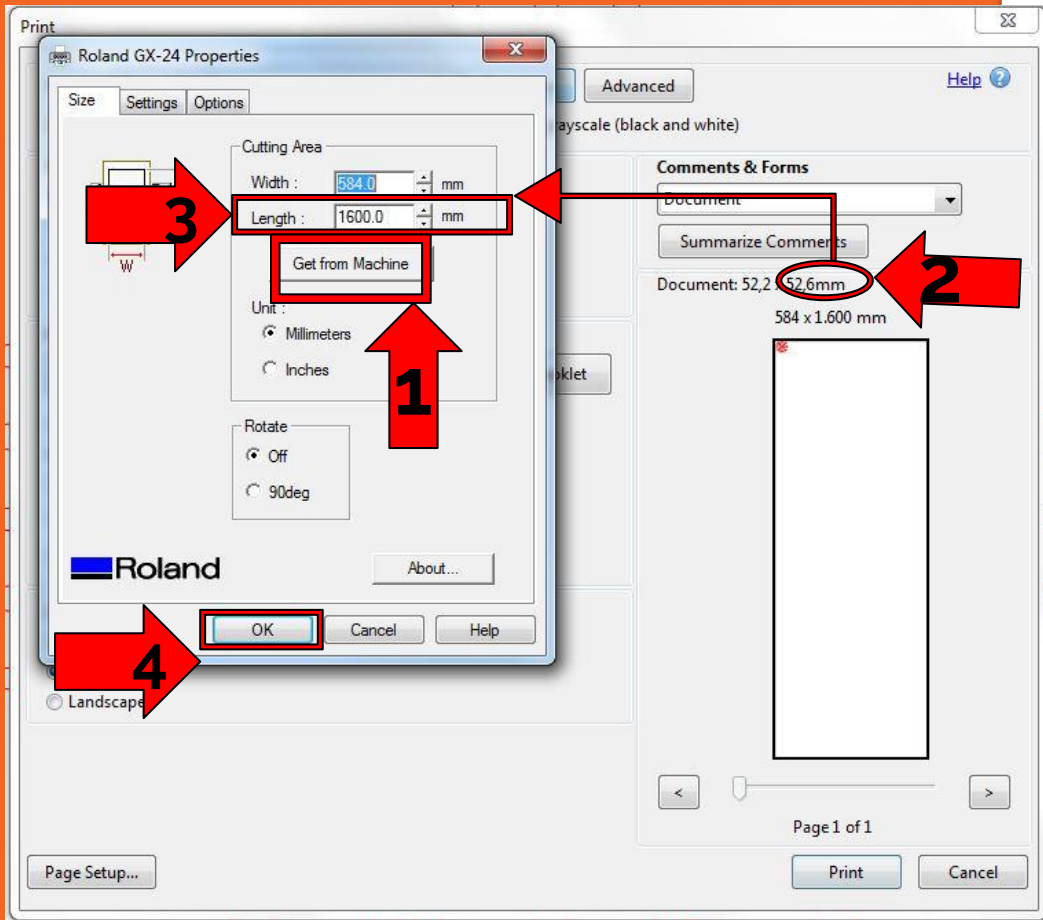




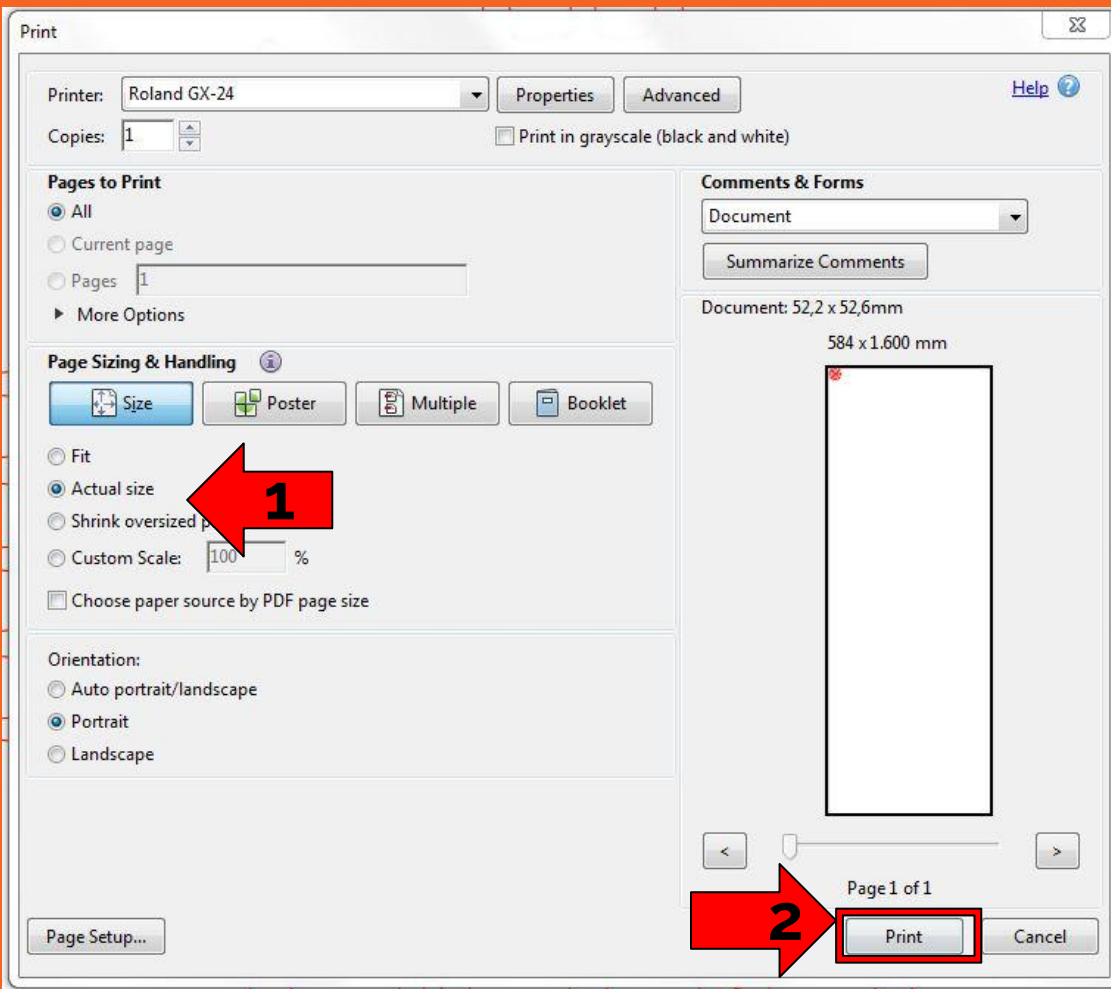
10 . Settings

1. Choose Roland
2. Choose "Actual size"
3. Press "Properties"

11. Properties



1. Press “Get from machine”
2. Check height
3. Change “Length”
1 cm longer than the file
4. Press “OK”



12 . Settings

1. Check "Actual size"
2. Press Print

11. Finishing up

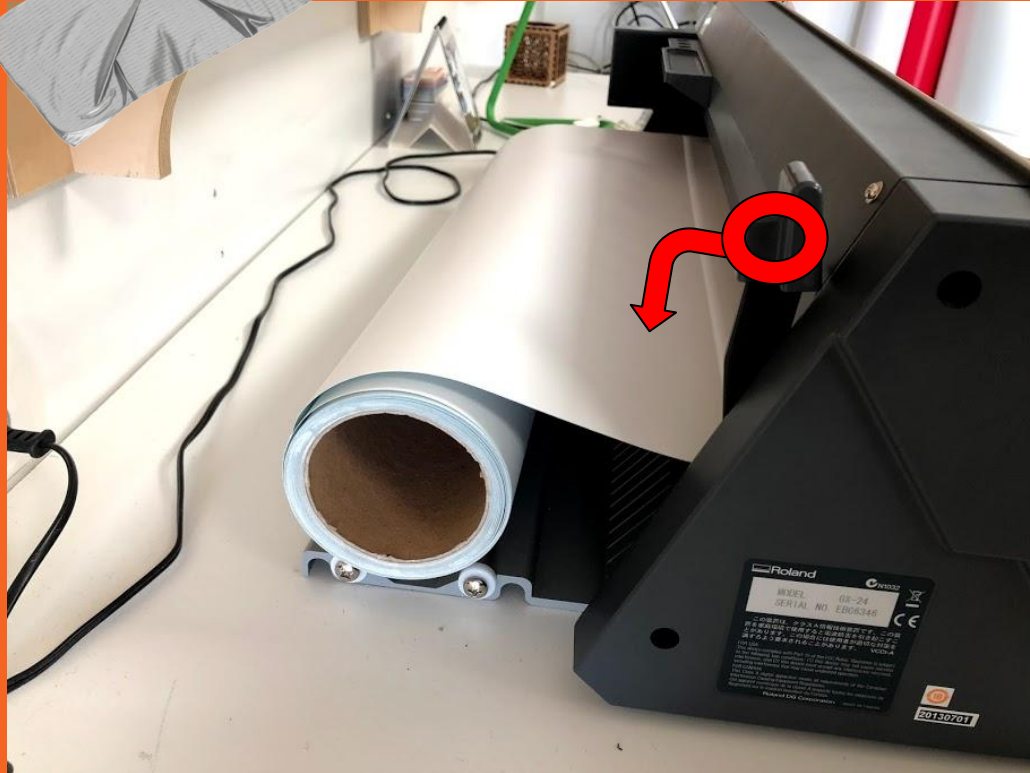
- Press "MENU"
- Check screen
- Press menu until "Unsetup" will show up
- Press "ENTER"



12. Taking the material out

→ **Lever pulled down**

The material will become loose and you can take the material out of the vinyl cutter



Now you can cut your design from the roll



And then the plucking begins :)
